ORDER OF AFFIRMANCE

This is a proper person appeal from a district court summary judgment in a tort action. Sixth Judicial District Court, Pershing County; Richard Wagner, Judge.

Upon review of the record and appellant's civil proper person appeal statement, we conclude that the district court did not err in finding that summary judgment in favor of respondent was appropriate in this matter. See NRCP 56; Wood v. Safeway, Inc., 121 Nev. 724, 729, 121 P.3d 1026, 1029 (2005) (explaining that summary judgment is appropriate if the pleadings and other evidence, viewed in the light most favorable to the nonmoving party, show that there are no genuine issues of material fact in dispute and the moving party is entitled to judgment as a matter of law).

Accordingly, we

ORDER the judgment of the district court AFFIRMED.
