These are proper person appeals from orders of the district court denying a motion for acquittal and a motion for mistrial. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Valorie Vega, Judge. We elect to consolidate these appeals for disposition. NRAP 3(b).

Because no statute or court rule permits an appeal from an order denying the aforementioned motions, we lack jurisdiction. Castillo v. State, 106 Nev. 349, 352, 792 P.2d 1133, 1135 (1990). Accordingly, we ORDER these appeals DISMISSED.¹
