ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a proper person appeal from an order of the district court dismissing a post-conviction petition for a writ of habeas corpus. Seventh Judicial District Court, White Pine County; Steve L. Dobrescu, Judge.

The State has filed a motion to dismiss the appeal due to the late filing of the notice of appeal. The district court entered its order denying appellant's petition on February 18, 2011. The district court served notice of entry of that order on appellant on February 18, 2011. Appellant did not file the notice of appeal, however, until April 11, 2011, after the expiration of the thirty-day appeal period prescribed by NRS 34.575. "[A]n untimely notice of appeal fails to vest jurisdiction in this court." Lozada v. State, 110 Nev. 349, 352, 871 P.2d 944, 946 (1994).
