ORDER OF AFFIRMANCE

This is an appeal from an order of the district court revoking appellant Tabitha Anna Yokum's probation. Sixth Judicial District Court, Humboldt County; Michael Montero, Judge.

Yokum contends that the district court abused its discretion by imposing her original sentence instead of a modified sentence or residential confinement. Yokum has not challenged the district court's decision to revoke her probation and she has not demonstrated that the district court abused its discretion by ordering her original sentence to be executed. See NRS 176A.630. Accordingly, we

ORDER the judgment of the district court AFFIRMED.
