ORDER DISMISSING APPEALS¹

On July 22, 2011, this court ordered attorney Brent D. Percival to personally pay, within ten days from that order's date, \$200 to the Supreme Court Law Library and to provide proof of payment to this court. To date, Percival has failed to pay the sanction and provide proof of payment to this court.

Further, our July 22 order also gave appellant 11 days to (1) pay the filing fee for the newly docketed appeal in Docket No. 58850; (2) file case appeal statements for both appeals, clarifying who represents him; (3) file docketing statements for both appeals; and (4) file a transcript request form or certificate of no transcript request pertaining to both

appeals. We cautioned that failure to comply with those directives could result in the imposition of additional sanctions, including dismissal.

Although appellant filed the case appeal statement in Docket No. 58342 on the same day that our July 22 order was entered, he has failed to otherwise comply with or respond to our order in any way. Accordingly, we conclude that dismissal is warranted and hereby dismiss these appeals. The \$200 sanction against attorney Percival and the filing fee for Docket No. 58850 remain due; Percival has 11 days from the date of this order to pay the sanction and provide proof of the sanction's payment to this court. Appellant and the attorney filing the appeal in Docket No. 58850, Barry Levinson, have 11 days from the date of this order to pay the filing fee. Failure to comply with this order may result in additional sanctions, including referral to the State Bar.

It is so ORDERED.
