## ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL AND REFERRING COUNSEL TO STATE BAR

On May 4, 2012, this court entered an order conditionally imposing sanctions on appellant's counsel for failure to file the transcript request form or a certificate that no transcript is to be requested and the docketing statement. Specifically, we directed attorney Shelley Lubritz to pay the sum of \$500 to the Supreme Court Law Library and provide this court with proof of such payment by May 21, 2012. As set forth in the order, the sanction would have been automatically vacated if Ms. Lubritz filed and served the transcript request form or a certificate that no transcript is to be requested and the docketing statement by May 15, 2012. To date, Ms. Lubritz has neither filed the documents nor provided this court with proof of payment of the sanction. Accordingly, we dismiss
