## ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

Notice of entry of the district court's August 31, 2011, order was served on appellant by respondents' counsel via U.S. mail on August 31, 2011. Because service of the notice of entry was by mail, appellant had 33 days from the date of service to file his notice of appeal. <u>See</u> NRAP 4(a)(1); NRAP 26(c). Appellant's notice of appeal was therefore due to be filed in the district court on or before October 3, 2011. Appellant filed his notice of appeal on October 12, 2011, nine days after the 33-day period for filing his notice of appeal had run. Since appellant's notice of appeal was untimely filed, we lack jurisdiction to consider this appeal. <u>See Healy v.</u> <u>Volkswagenwerk</u>, 103 Nev. 329, 331, 741 P.2d 432, 433 (1987) (noting that an untimely notice of appeal fails to vest jurisdiction in this court). Accordingly, we

ORDER this appeal DISMISSED.<sup>1</sup>
