


ORDER DENYING PETITION


This original petition for a writ of prohibition, or in the alternative, writ of mandamus challenges an order of the district court affirming a conviction in justice court. Petitioner Brinson Reinold requests this court to direct the district court to reverse his conviction and remand for a new trial. See NRS 34.160; NRS 34.320; Round Hill Gen. Imp. Dist. v. Newman, 97 Nev. 601, 603-04, 637 P.2d 534, 536 (1981). Specifically, Reinold claims that the district court incorrectly concluded that he could not challenge the State's use of an affidavit pursuant to NRS 50.135 because it was not properly challenged prior to the justice court proceedings. He also alleges that there was insufficient evidence to sustain his conviction. We conclude that Reinold has not met his burden of demonstrating that extraordinary relief is appropriate. The petition does not include the district court order affirming his justice court conviction, the transcript of the proceedings in the justice court, or other

necessary documents to support his claims.¹ Because, he did not provide sufficient information necessary for this court's review of the petition, see NRAP 21(a)(3), (4), we

ORDER the petition DENIED.
