ORDER OF DISBARMENT BY CONSENT

The Southern Nevada Disciplinary Board and attorney Robert Bradley Neff, Bar No. 4125, have filed, pursuant to SCR 112, a joint petition for Neff's disbarment by consent. The petition is supported by Neff's affidavit, in which he states that he consents to disbarment and does so freely and voluntarily; that he has not been subjected to any coercion or duress; that he is fully aware of the implications of his consent; and that he has had an opportunity to consult with counsel prior to consenting to disbarment. Neff concedes that the material facts in the petition are true. He submits the affidavit with full knowledge that if the state bar were to prosecute his case, he could not successfully defend against the charges.

Pursuant to SCR 112(1), an attorney who is the subject of an investigation or proceeding involving allegations of misconduct may

consent to disbarment by submitting the requisite affidavit. Neff's affidavit meets the requirements of SCR 112(1). The joint petition meets the requirements of SCR 112(2). Therefore, the petition for disbarment by consent is granted. Robert Bradley Neff is hereby disbarred. The parties shall comply with the applicable provisions of SCR 115 and SCR 121.1 regarding notice and publication.

It is so ORDERED.
