ORDER DENYING PETITION

FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI OR MANDAMUS

This original petition for a writ of certiorari or mandamus seeks to challenge petitioners' municipal court convictions for contributing to the delinquency of a minor and petitioner Jensen's conviction for possession of drug paraphernalia, and the district court's order denying petitioners' appeals from those convictions. We have considered the petition on file herein, and we are not satisfied that this court's intervention by way of extraordinary writ is warranted. Accordingly, we deny the petition. See NRAP 21(b); NRS 34.020; NRS 34.160; Zamarripa v. District Court, 103 Nev. 638, 640, 747 P.2d 1386, 1387 (1987); Poulos v. District Court, 98 Nev. 453, 455, 652 P.2d 1177, 1178 (1982).
