ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL


This is an appeal from district court post-divorce decree orders concerning child custody. Eighth Judicial District Court, Family Court Division, Clark County; Bill Henderson, Judge.


When our review of the NRAP 3(g) documents revealed a potential jurisdictional defect, we directed appellant to show cause why this appeal should not be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. Specifically, it appeared that the orders designated in the notice of appeal are not substantively appealable because no appeal may be taken from temporary child custody orders that are subject to further review. See In re Temporary Custody of Five Minors, 105 Nev. 441, 777 P.2d 901 (1989). Appellant timely responded to our show cause order, asserting that the district court denied appellant's motion to modify custody on a permanent basis and that the orders are not subject to further review, as no further proceedings were scheduled before the district court.


Having considered appellant's response to our show cause order, we conclude that the orders challenged in this appeal are temporary child custody orders, which are not substantively appealable. See id. Notably, the district court's orders demonstrate that, at a minimum, the parties' custody dispute as to the thirteen-year-old child has not been

finally determined. Thus, no order finally determining or altering the parties' custody arrangement has been entered. See NRAP 3A(b)(8). Once an order finally resolving all custody issues as to both children is entered, any aggrieved party may appeal from that order. Because the challenged orders fail to confer jurisdiction on this court, we

ORDER this appeal DISMISSED.
