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ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS OR PROHIBITION

This original petition for a writ of mandamus or prohibition challenges a district court order denying class certification in a wrongful foreclosure action.

A writ of mandamus is available to compel the performance of an act that the law requires or to control an arbitrary or capricious exercise of discretion. NRS 34.160; <u>International Game Tech. v. Dist. Ct.</u>, 124 Nev. 193, 197, 179 P.3d 556, 558 (2008). A writ of prohibition may be warranted when the district court exceeds its jurisdiction. NRS 34.320. Where there is no plain, speedy, and adequate remedy in the ordinary

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course of law, NRS 34.170; NRS 34.330, extraordinary relief may be available. <u>Smith v. District Court</u>, 107 Nev. 674, 677, 679, 818 P.2d 849, 851, 853 (1991). Either writ is an extraordinary remedy, and whether such a writ will be considered is within this court's sole discretion. <u>Id.</u> at 677, 818 P.2d at 851. It is petitioner's burden to demonstrate that our extraordinary intervention is warranted. <u>Pan v. Dist. Ct.</u>, 120 Nev. 222, 228, 88 P.3d 840, 844 (2004).

Having considered the petition and its supporting documents, we conclude that our intervention by way of extraordinary relief is not warranted. NRAP 21(b)(1); <u>Smith</u>, 107 Nev. at 677, 818 P.2d at 851.

Accordingly, we

ORDER the petition DENIED.
