ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

Appellants have filed a "Request for Huneycutt Remand," so that the district court may consider appellants' motion for reconsideration of the order being challenged on appeal. See Foster v. Dingwall 126 Nev. ___, 228 P.3d 453 (2010) (clarifying the remand procedure set forth in Huneycutt v. Hunecutt, 94 Nev. 79, 575 P.3d 585 (1978)).
