## ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS

This is an original petition for a writ of mandamus challenging a district court order denying a summary judgment motion in a tort action.

A writ of mandamus is available to compel the performance of an act that the law requires or to control an arbitrary or capricious exercise of discretion. NRS 34.160; International Game Tech. v. Dist. Ct., 124 Nev. 193, 197, 179 P.3d 556, 558 (2008). It is within this court's discretion to determine if a writ petition will be considered. Smith v. District Court, 107 Nev. 674, 677, 818 P.2d 849, 851 (1991). Petitioners bear the burden of demonstrating that extraordinary relief is warranted. Pan v. Dist. Ct., 120 Nev. 222, 228, 88 P.3d 840, 844 (2004).

Having considered the writ petition and the documents attached thereto, we conclude that petitioners have not demonstrated that

extraordinary relief is warranted at this time. <u>Id.</u> Accordingly, we deny the writ petition. NRAP 21(b)(1); <u>Smith</u>, 107 Nev. at 677, 818 P.2d at 851. ORDER the petition DENIED.<sup>1</sup>
