ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is an appeal purportedly from an order of the district court denying appellant's motion to proceed in forma pauperis. Second Judicial District Court, Washoe County; Brent T. Adams, Judge.

The right to appeal is statutory; where no statute or court rule provides for an appeal, no right to appeal exists. Castillo v. State, 106 Nev. 349, 352, 792 P.2d 1133, 1135 (1990). No statute or court rule provides for an appeal from an order denying a motion to proceed in forma pauperis. Moreover, we note that the district court entered an order subsequent to the filing of the instant notice of appeal in which the district court reconsidered and granted the motion to proceed in forma pauperis. The appeal is therefore moot. Accordingly, we

ORDER this appeal DISMISSED.
