ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS OR, IN THE ALTERNATIVE, PROHIBITION

This is an original petition for a writ of mandamus or, in the alternative, prohibition seeking an order compelling the district court to issue a ruling on and grant certain pretrial motions in the underlying divorce proceeding.

In this petition, petitioner asserts that the district court has not ruled on certain pretrial motions, including two motions for interim attorney fees filed on July 3, 2012, and October 3, 2012, respectively. In the motions, petitioner claims that he is at a financial disadvantage and requests an award of attorney fees from the real party in interest to assist him in defending the divorce action. <u>See</u> NRS 125.040(1)(c) (providing that the district court may require one party to pay money to enable the other party to defend a divorce suit). Petitioner also contends that he filed in the district court a motion to continue the trial, so that he may obtain

SUPREME COURT OF NEVADA attorney fees and adequately prepare his case. Petitioner requests that we direct the district court to rule on and/or grant these motions.

Having reviewed the petition, we decline to exercise our original jurisdiction and consider this matter at this time, when the district court has not yet resolved petitioner's motions. See NRAP 21(b)(1); Smith v. District Court, 107 Nev. 674, 677, 818 P.2d 849, 851 (1991) (stating that the issuance of an extraordinary writ is purely discretionary with this court). We are confident that the district court will resolve these matters as expeditiously as its calendar permits. Accordingly, we

ORDER the petition DENIED.
