



ORDER

These are appeals from a judgment of conviction, pursuant to a jury verdict, of one count of possession of a stolen vehicle, one count of possession of a firearm by an exfelon, one count of possession of a controlled substance, one count of burglary, one count of robbery with the use of a deadly weapon, two counts of burglary while in possession of a firearm, one count of robbery with the use of a deadly weapon, and one count of attempted robbery with the use of a deadly weapon. On February 17, 2000, appellant filed a notice of appeal in proper person.
