ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is an appeal from the district court's order of dismissal for failure to comply with NRC 16.1. On May 5, 2000, appellant filed a motion to remand this matter to the district court. Appellant previously filed in this court a copy of the district court's March 15, 2000 order certifying that upon remand, it would grant appellant's motion for reconsideration, vacate its order of dismissal, and hear respondent's motion to dismiss on its merits. See Huneycutt v. Huneycutt, 94 Nev. 79, 575 P.2d 585 (1978).

Cause appearing, we grant appellant's motion to remand. Accordingly, we remand this matter to the district court pursuant to its certification, and we dismiss this appeal.
