## ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS

This original petition for a writ of mandamus challenges district court orders granting partial summary judgment and a motion to amend a complaint in a tort action.

A writ of mandamus is available to compel the performance of an act that the law requires or to control an arbitrary or capricious exercise of discretion. NRS 34.160; Int'l Game Tech., Inc. v. Second Judicial Dist. Court, 124 Nev. 193, 197, 179 P.3d 556, 558 (2008). Mandamus is an extraordinary remedy, and whether a petition will be considered is within our sole discretion. Smith v. Eighth Judicial Dist. Court, 107 Nev. 674, 677, 679, 818 P.2d 849, 851, 853 (1991). Mandamus

will not issue when the petitioners have a plain, speedy, and adequate remedy at law, NRS 34.170; NRS 34.330, and we have consistently held that an appeal is generally an adequate legal remedy precluding writ relief. *Pan v. Eighth Judicial Dist. Court*, 120 Nev. 222, 224, 88 P.3d 840, 841 (2004).

Having considered the petition and appendix, we conclude that our intervention by way of extraordinary relief is not warranted. NRAP 21(b)(1); *Smith*, 107 Nev. at 677, 818 P.2d at 851. Specifically, petitioners have an adequate legal remedy in the form of an appeal from any adverse final judgment. *Pan*, 120 Nev. at 224, 88 P.3d at 841. Accordingly, we

ORDER the petition DENIED.
