ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is an appeal from a district court order denying a petition for early release from the registration requirements imposed by NRS 179D.490. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Kathleen E. Delaney, Judge.

Respondent has moved to dismiss this appeal as moot. See *Personhood Nev. v. Bristol*, 126 Nev. ___, ___, 245 P.3d 572, 574 (2010) (explaining that because mootness is a question of justiciability, "a controversy must be present through all stages of the proceeding"). The district court denied appellant's petition on the ground that an injunction entered in Eighth Judicial District Court Case No. 08A564966 precluded the court from granting the petition. As a written order has now been entered lifting that injunction, we conclude that this appeal is moot. Accordingly, we

ORDER this appeal DISMISSED.
