
## ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION AND REFERRAL TO DISCIPLINARY BOARD

This is a joint petition pursuant to SCR 111(4) by bar counsel and attorney Gerry G. Zobrist requesting that this court enter an order temporarily suspending Zobrist from the practice of law and referring him to the appropriate board for discipline. The petition is supported by certified copies of documents evidencing Zobrist's conviction in the United States District Court, District of Nevada, pursuant to a guilty plea, of one count of conspiracy to commit bank and wire fraud in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1343, 1344, and 1349, a felony. *See* SCR 111(1).

Pursuant to SCR 111, temporary suspension and referral to the appropriate disciplinary board are mandatory when an attorney has been convicted of a "serious" crime, which includes a felony. SCR 111(6)-(8). Having reviewed the petition and the supporting documentation submitted by the parties, we conclude that the petition conclusively establishes Zobrist's conviction of a serious crime. Accordingly, we temporarily suspend Zobrist from the practice of law and refer this matter to the Southern Nevada Disciplinary Board for the initiation of formal

SUPREME COURT OF NEVADA disciplinary proceedings in which the sole issue to be determined is the extent of discipline to be imposed. See SCR 111(7), (8).

It is so ORDERED.
