*ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL*

This is a proper person appeal from an order partially dismissing a post-conviction petition for a writ of habeas corpus. Seventh Judicial District Court, White Pine County; Gary Fairman, Judge.

On November 21, 2013, the district court dismissed 3 of the 7 claims raised in appellant's post-conviction petition for a writ of habeas corpus and directed the State to file an answer to the remaining claims.
