ORDER DISMISSING PETITION FOR WRIT OF QUO WARRANTO

This is a pro se petition seeking a writ of quo warranto.

Petitioner Russell Gates seeks a writ of quo warranto in an effort to oust respondent Gerry G. Zobrist from the office of justice of the peace for the Las Vegas Township. Mr. Zobrist, however, does not occupy the office of justice of the peace. Gates' petition for quo warranto relief to remove Mr. Zobrist from that office is therefore moot, *Personhood Nev. v. Bristol*, 126 Nev. ____, ___, 245 P.3d 572, 574 (2010) (providing that a case is moot when a live controversy no longer exists), and we dismiss the petition on this basis.
