
ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS OR PROHIBITION


This petition for a writ of mandamus or prohibition challenges an order striking petitioner's affidavit of bias and prejudice to disqualify Judge Gerald W. Hardcastle and striking petitioner's attorney's certificate and statement of bias and prejudice. The petition requests a writ of mandamus ordering Judge Hardcastle to assign the matter to another judge to determine whether he should be disqualified, and a writ of prohibition preventing Judge Hardcastle from proceeding in this case until the disqualification issue is resolved.


We have considered the petition, and we are not satisfied that this court's intervention by way of extraordinary relief is warranted at this time. Accordingly, we deny the petition. See NRAP 21(b); NRS 1.235(3); City of Sparks v. District Court, 112 Nev. 952, 920 P.2d 1014 (1996);
