Petitioner argues in his petition that this court should compel respondent to rule on pending motions for default and to dismiss in the Petitioner has filed a notice of underlying district court proceedings. appeal in Docket No. 66709, however, challenging the district court's order denying his motion for default and granting defendants' motion to dismiss. As petitioner has already received the relief he requests in his petition, the writ petition is now moot. See Personhood Nev. v. Bristol, 126 Nev. ____, 245 P.3d 572, 574 (2010) (providing that a case is moot when a live controversy no longer exists). Accordingly, we dismiss the petition for a writ of mandamus.
