## ORDER OF AFFIRMANCE

This is an appeal from an order of the district court denying a post-conviction petition requesting genetic marker testing pursuant to NRS 176.0918.<sup>1</sup> Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; James M. Bixler, Judge.

Appellant filed his post-conviction petition for genetic marker testing on August 28, 2013. Appellant failed to demonstrate that he met the requirements for genetic marker testing. See NRS 176.0918(3). First, he failed to set forth the results of "all prior genetic marker analysis performed on evidence in the trial which resulted in [appellant's] conviction." NRS 176.0918(3)(d). Second, appellant failed to demonstrate a reasonable possibility that he "would not have been prosecuted or convicted if exculpatory results had been obtained through a genetic marker analysis." NRS 176.0918(3)(b). The State's case against appellant did not include DNA evidence from the bathing suit or knife. Appellant

did not touch the bathing suit and the sexual assault was interrupted. Further, the victim knew appellant and immediately identified appellant as the person who sexually assaulted her. Appellant's vague claims regarding the crime lab technician and crime lab not being accredited were not sufficient to demonstrate he would not have been prosecuted or convicted. Therefore, the district court did not err in denying the petition, and we

ORDER the judgment of the district court AFFIRMED.
