ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

On November 13, 2014, this court ordered Smith to show cause why this appeal should not be dismissed as moot, as the election at issue has concluded and Smith was not elected to the office that she sought. Having considered the parties' timely responses, we conclude that this appeal is moot, as we cannot provide any effective relief relating to the past election. *See Personhood Nev. v. Bristol*, 126 Nev. ___, ___, 245 P.3d 572, 574 (2010). Moreover, as this appeal presents questions unique

to appellant and thus not of widespread public importance, we decline to consider this appeal as capable of repetition yet evading review. *Id.* Accordingly, we

ORDER this appeal DISMISSED.
