ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is an appeal from a district court order changing venue. First Judicial District Court, Carson City; James Todd Russell, Judge.

In response to this court's order to show cause why this appeal should not be dismissed for lack of standing, appellants contend that even though their motion to dismiss the underlying action alternatively requested a venue change and they filed a separate demand to change venue, they have standing to appeal the venue order because they did not obtain the entirety of their requested relief. They further argue that NRS 38.246 (governing venue under the arbitration statutes) is jurisdictional, and thus, the district court was required to dismiss the case. Respondents have replied, arguing that appellants are not aggrieved by the order, which granted their alternative request to change venue, and regardless, appellants' November 25, 2014, notice of appeal was untimely filed more

OF NEVADA than 30 days after the July 31, 2014, order. **Respondents** request sanctions on the basis that the appeal is frivolous.

Having considered the parties' arguments and the documents before this court, we dismiss this appeal on standing and timeliness grounds. NRAP 3A(a) and (b)(6); Valley Bank of Nev. v. Ginsburg, 110 Nev. 440, 446, 874 P.2d 729, 734 (1994). We deny respondents' request for sanctions.

It is so ORDERED.
