ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a pro se appeal from the "conviction." Third Judicial District Court, Lyon County; Robert E. Estes, Senior Judge.

This court's review of this appeal reveals a jurisdictional defect. Specifically, the appeal is untimely filed. The judgment of conviction was entered on November 5, 2007. Appellant did not file the notice of appeal until December 31, 2014, well after the expiration of the 30-day appeal period prescribed by NRAP 4(b). "[A]n untimely notice of appeal fails to vest jurisdiction in this court." Lozada v. State, 110 Nev. 349, 352, 871 P.2d 944, 946 (1994). Further, appellant previously appealed from his judgment of conviction. See Deyerle v. State, Docket No. 50617 (Order of Affirmance, February 4, 2009). To the extent that appellant attempts to appeal from the district court's decision on a post-conviction petition for a writ of habeas corpus, review of the district court docket and minute entries reveals that no decision, oral or written, had

SUPREME COURT OF NEVADA been made on the petition when appellant filed his appeal. Accordingly, we lack jurisdiction over this appeal, and we

ORDER this appeal DISMISSED.
