## ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is a pro se appeal assigned to the court's pilot program for civil litigants proceeding without counsel. Fifth Judicial District Court, Nye County; Kimberly A. Wanker, Judge.

Our review of the documents transmitted to this court pursuant to NRAP 3(g) reveals a jurisdictional defect. Specifically, Appellant's notice of appeal states that appellant appeals the decision of the district court "ignoring/delaying in hearing appeal violates the 14<sup>th</sup> amendment: Elcock v. Henderson, 947 F.2d 1004 (CA 2 1991) – due process violation – commonplace in Nye." Appellant fails to identify any potential appealable order. See NRAP 3(c)(1)(B) (requiring the notice of appeal to designate the judgment or order being appealed). Accordingly, we conclude that we lack jurisdiction, and we
