ORDER DENYING PETITION

FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS

This is a proper person petition for a writ of mandamus challenging the calculation of petitioner's two consecutive 20-year sentences as a single 40-year sentence pursuant to this court's decision in Nevada Dep't Prisons v. Bowen, 103 Nev. 477, 745 P.2d 697 (1987).

We have reviewed the documents on file with this court, and we conclude that our intervention by extraordinary writ is not warranted. NRS 34.170; see also NRS 34.724; Round Hill Gen. Imp. Dist. v. Newman, 97 Nev. 601, 637 P.2d 534 (1981). Accordingly, we deny the petition.
