*ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR  
WRIT OF MANDAMUS*

This is an original pro se petition for a writ of mandamus in which petitioner John Lockett seeks a writ directing the district court to vacate its order to show cause why the district court should grant the order to proceed in forma pauperis.

Based on the record, the court cannot conclude that that the district court's actions in issuing the order to show cause were arbitrary or capricious. NRS 34.160; *Int'l Game Tech., Inc. v. Second Judicial Dist. Court*, 124 Nev. 193, 197, 179 P.3d 556, 558 (2008). We therefore
