



ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is an appeal from a judgment of conviction. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Kathleen E. Delaney, Judge.

Appellant has filed a notice of voluntary withdrawal of her appeal. Appellant's counsel states that he has advised appellant of "all possible consequences which could result from her withdrawal of this appeal." Attached to the notice is an affidavit from appellant in which she explains she has been advised of all possible consequences and after considering her options and any ramifications, she requests her counsel to withdraw her appeal.
