

*ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL*

Appellant Joel Ross Sempier appeals from a district court order partially denying his November 7, 2013, postconviction petition for a writ of habeas corpus and supplemental petition. Second Judicial District Court, Washoe County; Scott N. Freeman, Judge.

Sempier asserts the district court's order did not resolve his claim of ineffective assistance of appellate counsel and a review of the record demonstrates he is correct. Because the district court's order did not resolve all of Sempier's claims, it was not a final appealable order. See NRS 34.575(1); *Mann v. State*, 118 Nev. 351, 356-57, 46 P.3d 1228, 1231-32 (2002). Therefore, Sempier's notice of appeal was premature and we lack jurisdiction to consider this appeal. Accordingly, we

ORDER this appeal DISMISSED.
