*ORDER DENYING PETITIONS*


These petitions for a writ of mandamus appear to seek an order directing respondent to stop taking action in district court case numbers CR07-1714, CR08-1585, and CR08-1586. Petitioner appears to assert that because respondent recused himself from participating in another one of petitioner's cases respondent is also prohibited from taking action in any of petitioner's other cases.
