ORDER OF AFFIRMANCE

Warden Isidro Baca appeals from a district court order granting the postconviction petition a writ of habeas corpus that Daniel Wagnanski filed on June 29, 2016. First Judicial District Court, Carson City; James E. Wilson, Judge.

Wagnanski's petition challenged the computation of time served. Baca argues the district court erred by granting the petition because Wagnanski was not entitled to have statutory credits applied to his minimum sentence under NRS 209.4465(7)(b). In light of the Nevada Supreme Court's recent decision in *Williams v. State*, 133 Nev. ___, 402 P.3d 1260 (2017), we conclude the district court did not err in granting the petition, and we

ORDER the judgment of the district court AFFIRMED.
