ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is an appeal from a judgment of conviction, pursuant to a guilty plea, of one count of robbery. The judgment of conviction was entered by the district court on June 30, 2000. The notice of appeal was filed on August 25, 2000, after the thirty-day appeal period prescribed by NRAP 4(b). An untimely notice of appeal fails to vest jurisdiction in this court. See *Lozada v. State*, 110 Nev. 349, 871 P.2d 944 (1994).

Accordingly, on September 20, 2000, this court entered an order directing counsel for appellant to show cause why this appeal should not be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. Counsel for appellant has not responded to our order. We conclude that we lack jurisdiction to entertain this appeal, and we

ORDER this appeal dismissed.
