

ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS

This is an original proper person petition for a writ of mandamus seeking an order compelling the clerk of the First Judicial District Court to file petitioner's notice of appeal. Petitioner failed to provide any documentation in support of the petition, in violation of NRAP 21(a), and has failed to pay the filing fee required by NRS 2.250. We have considered this petition for a writ of mandamus, and we are not satisfied that this court's intervention by way of extraordinary relief is warranted at this time. Accordingly, we deny the petition. See NRAP 21(b); State ex rel. Dep't Transp. v. Thompson, 99 Nev. 358, 662 P.2d 1338 (1983).
