## ORDER OF AFFIRMANCE

Kevin A. Kelly appeals from an order of the district court denying the postconviction petition for a writ a habeas corpus filed on September 1, 2017. First Judicial District Court, Carson City; James E. Wilson, Judge.

In his petition, Kelly claimed the Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) improperly declined to apply his statutory credits toward his minimum term. The district court denied the petition because Kelly is serving a prison term for robbery, a category B felony, see NRS 200.380(2), that he committed in 2015. For those reasons the district court found the NDOC may only apply Kelly's statutory credits toward his maximum term pursuant to NRS 209.4465(8)(d). Given these
