This is a pro se appeal from a judgment of conviction. Second Judicial District Court, Washoe County; Scott N. Freeman, Judge.

This court's preliminary review of this appeal reveals a jurisdictional defect. Specifically, the district court entered the judgment of conviction on August 5, 2014. Appellant did not file the notice of appeal, however, until November 28, 2018, well after the expiration of the 30-day appeal period prescribed by NRAP 4(b).
