



*ORDER DENYING PETITION
FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS OR PROHIBITION*

This original, emergency petition for a writ of mandamus or prohibition challenges a district court decision to assert jurisdiction over the parties' custody dispute, mid-proceeding, without holding a simultaneous proceedings conference under NRS 125A.355 and the UCCJEA.

Petitioners bear the burden of demonstrating that our extraordinary intervention is warranted. *Pan v. Eighth Judicial Dist. Court*, 120 Nev. 222, 228, 88 P.3d 840, 844 (2004). In light of this burden, NRAP 21(a) requires that a petition for extraordinary relief contain, among other things, statements of the facts necessary to understand the issues presented in the petition and the reasons why the writ should issue, as well as copies of any necessary parts of the record. Here, petitioner failed to provide this court with a statement of facts sufficient to fully understand the issues raised, with a signed, written Nevada district court order, *see State, Div. Child & Fam. Servs. v. Dist. Ct.*, 120 Nev. 445, 451, 92 P.3d 1239, 1243 (2004) (recognizing that a clerk's "minute order" or a district court's


oral ruling is invalid for any purpose), with copies of the parties' motions, oppositions, or any other documents filed in the Nevada district court that concern the issues petitioner seeks to challenge in this writ petition, or with an explanation of why this petition was filed on an emergency basis more than two months after the challenged action occurred. Accordingly, we are unable to adequately evaluate the issues raised and

ORDER the petition DENIED.
