*ORDER OF REVERSAL AND REMAND*

Chandelle Sanchez appeals from a judgment of conviction entered pursuant to a guilty plea of possession of a controlled substance for the purpose of sale. Second Judicial District Court, Washoe County; Kathleen M. Drakulich, Judge.

The district court sentenced Sanchez to a prison term of two to six years. Sanchez claims this sentence is illegal because it exceeds the limits prescribed by the relevant statutes. The State concedes the error, notes the repeated references to Sanchez' crime as a category B felony were the result of clerical errors, and asserts Sanchez should have been sentenced pursuant to NRS 453.337(2)(a) and NRS 193.130(2)(d). We agree. Accordingly, we

ORDER the judgment of conviction REVERSED AND REMAND this matter to the district court for a new sentencing hearing.
