






ORDER DENYING PETITION

This original petition for a writ of mandamus seeks an order directing the district court to immediately process and resolve Brandon Demarlo Monghur's petition for a writ of habeas corpus filed in district court case number A-18-781231-W. Monghur asserts he filed his petition in August 2018 and the district court has not taken any action on his petition since September 2018. Although Monghur cites to an exhibit in his petition, he has not provided this court with any exhibits or other documentation to support his contentions. See NRAP 21(a)(4) (providing the petitioner shall submit an appendix containing all documents "essential to understand the matters set forth in the petition"). Therefore, without deciding upon the merits of any claims raised, we decline to exercise our original jurisdiction in this matter. See NRS 34.160; NRAP 21(b); *Pan v. Eighth Judicial Dist. Court*, 120 Nev. 222, 228, 88 P.3d 840, 844 (2004) ("Petitioner[] carr[ies] the burden of demonstrating that extraordinary relief is warranted."). We

expect the district court will resolve all pending matters as expeditiously as its calendar permits. See NRS 34.740. Accordingly, we

ORDER the petition DENIED.
