



ORDER OF AFFIRMANCE

Lashauna Doss appeals from an order of the district court revoking probation and an amended judgment of conviction. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Douglas W. Herndon, Judge.


Doss argues the district court abused its discretion by revoking her probation. Doss contends she did not willfully violate her probation, but rather only committed a violation because she was not taking her mental health medication and was improperly housed with another inmate in the Clark County Detention Center.

The decision to revoke probation is within the broad discretion of the district court, and will not be disturbed absent a clear showing of abuse. *Lewis v. State*, 90 Nev. 436, 438, 529 P.2d 796, 797 (1974). Evidence supporting a decision to revoke probation must merely be sufficient to reasonably satisfy the district court that the conduct of the probationer was not as good as required by the conditions of probation. *Id.*

At the revocation hearing, Doss stipulated that she had violated her probation by harming a fellow detention center inmate and acknowledged she had entered a guilty plea to battery on a protected person. Doss informed the district court of her mental health issues and

requested to be reinstated to probation. The district court noted Doss had a violent criminal history and that she is dangerous when she chooses not to take her mental health medication. The district court found Doss' conduct was not as good as required by the conditions of her probation and revoked her probation. Based on the record before this court, we conclude the district court did not abuse its discretion by revoking Doss' probation. Accordingly, we

ORDER the order revoking probation and amended judgment of conviction AFFIRMED.
