ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

On June 1, 2001, this court issued a notice directing appellant to file a docketing statement within 15 days. Because appellant failed to comply with that notice, we entered an order on July 17, 2001, that directed appellant to file the docketing statement within 10 days of the date of that order. We cautioned appellant that failure to timely file the docketing statement could result in the imposition of sanctions pursuant to NRAP 14(c).

Because appellant failed to comply with our July 17, 2001, order, on October 17, 2001, we entered an order that again directed appellant to file the docketing statement. We cautioned appellant that failure to file the docketing statement within 7 days of the date of that order could result in the dismissal of this appeal.

To date, appellant has failed to file the docketing statement or otherwise respond to this court's June 1, 2001, notice or July 17, 2001, and October 17, 2001, orders. Accordingly, we dismiss this appeal. NRAP 14(c) (failure to file a docketing statement within the time prescribed shall not affect the validity of the appeal, but is grounds for such action as the Supreme Court deems appropriate including sanctions and dismissal of the appeal).

It is so ORDERED.
