

## ORDER OF AFFIRMANCE

Keith Paul Bird appeals from a judgment of conviction, pursuant to a guilty plea, of robbery. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Kenneth C. Cory, Judge.

Bird contends the district court erred by denying his motion to withdraw his guilty plea, because the court applied the wrong standard. The district court found that, "taking all things into account," there was no "substantial, fair or just reason" to allow Bird to withdraw his guilty plea. Bird did not demonstrate the district court failed to consider the totality of the circumstances when it found there was no fair and just reason to withdraw the guilty plea. See Stevenson v. State, 131 Nev. 598, 603, 354 P.3d 1277, 1281 (2015). Accordingly, Bird has not demonstrated the district court erred by denying his motion.

Bird also contends the plea canvass was inadequate. Bird did not raise this claim below, and we decline to consider it on appeal in the

COURT OF APPEALS OF NEVADA first instance. See Rimer v. State, 131 Nev. 307, 328 n.3, 351 P.3d 697, 713 n.3 (2015). Accordingly, we

ORDER the judgment of conviction AFFIRMED.
