ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

This is a petition pursuant to SCR 102(4)(a) for temporary suspension of attorney James A. Stone, pending resolution of formal disciplinary proceedings. Stone was served with a copy of the petition.

We conclude that the petition and supplement, together with the affidavits and documents provided in support, demonstrate that Stone poses a substantial threat of serious harm, and that temporary suspension pursuant to SCR 102(4)(a) is thus appropriate.

Accordingly, we grant the state bar's petition. Attorney James A. Stone is temporarily suspended from the practice of law, pending resolution of the formal disciplinary proceedings against him. Stone shall comply with the provisions of SCR 102(4)(c). Both Stone and the state bar shall comply with the provisions of SCR 115.

It is so ORDERED.¹
