ORDER OF REMAND

This is an appeal from a district court order dismissing a petition for third-party visitation with a minor child. The sole issue on appeal is whether the district court was correct in finding NRS 125C.050 unconstitutional.

It appears from the briefs that the parties are not aware that NRS 125C.050 was amended since the district court issued its order in October 2000. Hence, in light of the recent amendment to NRS 125C.050, we order that this case be remanded to the district court with instructions to apply the newly-adopted NRS 125C.050. Accordingly, we

ORDER the case remanded.
