*ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL*

This is an appeal from a district court order denying a motion to adjudicate an attorney's lien. We previously entered an order directing appellant to show cause why this appeal should not be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. Specifically, it appeared that appellant was not a party to the underlying proceedings and lacked standing to appeal the challenged order. *See Albert D. Massi, Ltd. v.
