ORDER DENYING PETITION

This petition for a writ of mandamus seeks an order directing real party in interest Susan Bush to turn over her complete client file pertaining to Steven Larue Scott to petitioner Scott. Scott specifically seeks all information and evidence Bush found that is not part of the record of Scott's criminal proceedings and which led to an independent investigation. Included with the petition is an affidavit from Bush dated January 11, 2017, in which she states she has provided Scott with his entire file.

We have considered the petition on file herein, and we are not satisfied this court's intervention by way of extraordinary writ is warranted at this time. Accordingly, without deciding upon the merits of any claims raised therein, we deny the petition. *See* NRAP 21(b); *Pan v. Eighth Judicial Dist. Court*, 120 Nev. 222, 228, 88 P.3d 840, 844 (2004)

("Petitioner[] carr[ies] the burden of demonstrating that extraordinary relief is warranted."). Therefore, we

ORDER the petition DENIED.¹
